Brief History

The idea to form another age grade in Obiuno, Igboukwu was conceived in 1988, this was to take care of members excluded by Odenigbo age grade (first age grade in Obiuno) which limited their membership to people born in 1963. In view of this, those members excluded mostly from Onitsha branch headed by Mr. Jacob Izuegbunem (Omenamkpo) muted the idea of forming another age grade that will accommodate people born from 1964 to 1968.

The first official meeting was held on 27th December, 1988 at Primary School, Obiuno, Igboukwu, where the name Obinwanne was officially adopted as the name of the second and most vibrant age grade in Obiuno, Igboukwu.

The motio of Obinwanne age grade is Love, Peace and Progress and is guided by a constitution which has been reviewed two times in 2007 and 2018.

The pioneer Chairman of the age grade was Mr. Jacob Izuegbunem (Omenamkpo) and his administration lasted for 8 years (2 tenures) while Mr Callistus Igwilo became the Vice-Chairman. Nze Lawrence Umeiheukwu became the first Secretary while Late Eche Onyekwelu was the Assistant Secretary. Messrs Val Osunkwo and Eugene Ezeanyanaso were the Financial Secretary and Treasurer respectively.

The next administration was led by Late Elochukwu Ezeokoye (Elobest) while Mr Ifeanyi Okafor was the Secretary. Mr Calistus Igwilo was retained as the Vice-Chairman. BRIEF HISTORY OF EKWUEME AGE GRADE obiuno, igboukwu.

Ekwueme age grade was founded on the 30th of December, 1996 by a group of Obiuno village boys between the age bracket of 1969 and 1974 that took after Obinwanne age grade that stopped at 1968. The first inaugural meeting of this age grade was held on 30th Dec, 1996 with Late Mr Aloy Osunkwor as the pioneer chairman and Engr Onyekachi Onyekwelu as the secretary while Mr Chukwuka Ifebighi as the PRO which served as the interim caretaker committee. This caretaker committee led the age grade for a period of one year and handed over to an elected executives. The caretaker committee was able to lay a foundation that others were able to stand upon to forge ahead.

The committee in concensus with pioneer members of this age grade adopted the name Ekwueme considering the zeal with which it was founded which was based on "talk and do" as the group of boys were very energetic, vibrant and focused which received accolades of prominent personalities of the village. The committee introduced the pattern of greeting and the slogan which is 'Odinma Ekwueme ' and the reply was ' Udo na Ifunananya'. The caretaker committee also provided a conducive platform that ushered in a smooth transition to an elected executives on 30th December, 1997 which led to the emergence of Mr Ifeanyi Umeiheukwu as the 1st executive president of Ekwueme age grade Obiuno Igboukwu.

His regime drafted the 1st constitution that guided the age grade for many years before it was amended. The regime led the age grade for a period of 3 years from 1997 to the year 2000 as stipulated in the construction of the age grade and handed over to another government led by Mr Vinpaul Okafor, though his administration was characterized by controversies but was brought under control by concerned members who never want the bright light of Ekwueme age grade to go dim, the government ran through year 2000 to 2003.

Then Mr Okwuchukwu Ben Okeke mounted the mantle of leadership on 30th Dec, 2003 which runs for 3 years. His regime carried out distribution of writing materials such as customized excise books etc to all the primary schools in Obiuno under the Education Scholarship Scheme of Ekwueme age grade which was initiated by his predecessor but was delayed amidst controversies. With the intervention of late Mr Aloy Osunkwor (Obataobie Ekwueme age grade) in company of Mr Chukwudi Okafor , Anene Ezekafor and Echezona Ezeh.

The production and the distribution was successfully carried out, this singular act resuscitated the image of Ekwueme age grade. The beneficiaries of the scholarship scheme were grateful to witness an unprecedented event in the history of Obiuno as no group or association has ever remembered the pupils as at then. The government of Mr Ben Okwuchukwu Okeke scaled through 2003 to 2006 and handed over to Mr Ifeanyi Umeiheukwu who came back for a second term as allowed by constitution for a period of 2 terms leadership.

His regime which tagged 2nd missionary journey brought brought some amendments in our Constitution and introduction of certain policies that brought about economic buoyancy in the age grade and steped down after 3 years tenure expiry date of their selfless service 2007 to 2009. Mr Emeka Okafor took over from Mr Ifeanyi Umeiheukwu on December, 2009 and hosted the first ever flamboyant end of the year party in the history of the age grade on December 2013 at the resistance of one of our member Mr Kenneth Okonkwor (Obele nwa Jesus) who voluntarily and single handedly footing the bills of our meetings entertainment since inception of this age grade till date as a result of his philanthropic lifestyle. We can not forget his counterpart Mr Anisinna Vin Ofodum (Asuwaju) who also pays the of whatever we drink during our meetings. We sincerely appreciates who contribute immensely for the progress of this age grade either by cash or kind may you all be blessed in Jesus name.

The government of Mr Emeka Okafor

was re-elected for 2nd term which ended on December, 2015. The mantle of leadership moves to Mr Chukwudi Okafor who served for a single term. His administration practiced all inclusive government and bridged the gap between the rich and the poor among the members. He encouraged the poor in the age grade to come closer and feel the impact of brotherhood. The remove all clauses that scares aways some of our members and gained them back as one family. Everybody was made to have sence of belonging under this umbrella of Ekwueme irrespective of his economic status under his administration, being someone who was born and brought up in the local environment and resides close to home, he knows the local settings and characters, he is more of dynamic in his administration. Under his leadership Ekwueme is now sponsoring inter house competition in Obiuno primary school and looking forward to extend the project to Obiuno Central school and others in coming years by the special grace of God. The 2019 election of the age grade produced Mr Arinze Okonkwor (Akaoma jide aku) as the current president of Ekwueme age grade Obiuno Igboukwu whom we all believes that has all it takes to bring Ekwueme age and the entire Obiuno village to the next level.

EPILOGUE: In the book Jeremiah, God asked



Quite honestly, looking at the man popularly called EZE-AKAJIUGO, his life, style, motives, motivations, business sense and his genuine commitment to the service of humanity call for closer analysis particularly as his tenure as the executive chairman of Obiuno Community gradually comes to a tidy ending.

In passing, it is also good we look at his style of friendship with people and what accounts for his local popularity among our folks which also conduces to the fact that he is just living a life of service to his friends and people at no direct personal financial gains, or what lawyers call pecuniary considerations! This apparently sends some shivers down my spine! I have continued to marvel even to my bone marrow! What a man! In this day

So what is EZE-AKAJIUGO'S motivations and drivers?

The simple answer: the love to serve!

and age when MONEY is everything?

The question I keep asking myself is: how does EZE-AKAJIUGO achieve this selfless service at no gain to himself and without affecting his professional life as a busy Lagos lawyer! Many out there think he is being paid for whatever social or public relations, PR, job he does for his friends! There must be something that he gains, opines yet another group of admirers! We must however not mix core legal briefs with social duties. Being a professional lawyer, he ought to earn his fees where legal duties are in issue except he expressly opts for 'pro bono' services. For other PR or social services, no fees are charged.

How does he combine factors? I have come to now find out that he combines all these factors seamlessly in addition to being the chairman of his home Community Development Union of Obiuno Igbo-Ukwu.

In his about 4 yours on the saddle as the executive chairman of his Community, it's on record that he has never missed any

of its bi-monthly meetings and when you add the IDU Meetings, it comes to monthly attendance, that is, traveling to Igbo-Ukwu from his Lagos base every month compulsorily. And he never failed any!

But what does his score card look like as chairman of Obiuno Community during this four years tenure?

In brief, EZE-AKAJIUGO deployed a leadership model tagged: Obiuno integrated rural transformation program (OBIRTRANP) that would be delivered with no less than N700m Budget in four years.

OBIRTRANP is designed to run on a sectoral transformation basis covering security architecture, rural electricity/constant power supply, roads rehabilitation and erosion control, education and youth development, quality healthcare delivery, social infrastructure provisions, culture of honours with church/customs and traditions synergy, restoration of people confidence to Community Leadership via a convocation of Mass Return Celebration, provision of robust communication resources for effective Community relations etc.

Taking this from the rear to the foremost beginning, at inception of the tenure, EZE-AKAJIUGO held series of off-season meetings with the Executive Officers of Obiuno Community to agree on terms: vision, style, progammes contents and budget of the Administration in order to restore and rekindle the people's confidence to Community Leadership. Series of Stakeholder consultations across the shades of the citizenry were done so as to achieve a people-driven transformational agenda.

The timetable for the December 2018 Mass Return Celebration was agreed to as a fertile ground to raise funds that would fund the seemingly ambitious budget of the leadership.

In early January of 2017, a security summit was held with a selected few Stakeholders of Obiuno Community to review, overhaul and reposition the Obiuno security machinery and architecture for the 21st century emerging urban Community. This recorded a huge success as a few millions of naira was raised to refurbish our security automobiles... Toyota Hilux van, purchase new motorbikes, acquired new walking sticks and akara nuts, add more security beats and hire more security personnel with increased pay. New T-shirts were purchased to improve the image, that is, the 'look and feel' of the men in the frontline.

The planning for the Mass Return Celebration was pursued with vigour and all available resources. The planning, logistics and final execution of the Mass Return Celebration was valued at N20m. That done, the result was a huge success with over N100m realized on the first phase. A Mini-Launching was later followed up on Dec 28, 2019 with harvest nearly hitting the 8-digits.

By April of 2019, less than 4 months after the Mass Return Celebration, the GroundBreaking Ceremony for the building of the 2-storey Obiuno Mega Civic Center Project took place and thereafter, actual construction began. Today, if not for the covid-19 pandemic scourge and the sudden death of the lead contractor midstream, the entire civil engineering structure would have been completed. Where we are now is at the roofing stage as at May 2020 before national emergency lockdown was imposed in the whole of Nigeria. All hopes still remain high that before year end the rooftop would be done with.

The Obiuno Mega Civic Center Project is going on side by side with the N150m Obiuno Health Center Project being singularly undertaken by the highly indomitable public-spirited NNABUG-WU SONS who donated a whopping sum of N50M for the total rehabilitation, construction of brand new structures and provisions of drugs and equipment for the Health Center. Today an estimated sum in excess of N100m has gone into the health center facility with a best-in-class water borehole already sunk in to provide portable clean water, not just to the health center facility alone, but to other adjourning civic center facility. What an ambitious but well-structured and well-orchestrated transformation agenda taking place in a community in so short a time.

Towards the end of 2018, the leadership launched a massive roads rehabilitation program costing an estimated N10m to clean up the over 90 catchment pits and drainages, grade the uneven portions of the roads (for 2 months up tll Jan 2019) to ensure that all returning Families in all the parts of Obiuno Villages enjoy seamless access to their houses and homes. This project was pursued rigorously even up till January 2020.

From the later part of 2017, Obiuno finally sang a new song by bidding a final farewell to NEPA Darkness that for more than 3years engulfed the community before the arrival of the EZE-AKAJIU-GO led-Administration. All the four existing transformers came alive with PHCN regular power supply majorly within Obiuno Community at that earlier years of this regime and since 2017 till date, Obiuno Community had remained aglow all night and day! What a devastating blow to darkness by the current regime of EZE-AKAJIUGO led-Administration! The budget for revamping rural power supply in Obiuno was in excess of N25m from the point of entry to date. Every month, an average bills on all the four bulk-metered transformers stood at over N1.5m and for over 42 months.

Obiuno Community through our Administration also partnered with and supported some villages and Umunnas to replace both old and wooden poles in their areas to concrete poles as well as fully energized some wards or parts of Obiuno Community with electric poles and cables for them to have light for the first time ever.

For the first time and among other Communities around Obiuno Quarter, a seamless communication resources was put in place via the introduction of functional WhatsApp platforms across all Obiuno wards and Villages including a central Stakeholders' hub and other social media handles. Obiuno Community remains the only Quarter in Igbo-Ukwu to have a functional website: visit Obiuno@: www.obiunodevunion.com and it has remained functional till date. Obiuno Community has witnessed continuous publications of several colorful and informative events brochures from 2016, 2018 and 2019 including its financial statements and accounts on all projects executed and year ends. The 2020 legacy brochure and calendar promise to be chart bursters of all times.

The Culture of Honours, as a deliberate communal progamme targets the constant lubrication of the hallowed relationship between the Alor Cabinet of Obiuno, Ndi Nze N'Ozo'Society of Obiuno Community, the Women Wing, the indeginous clergy, the Churches in the community, the non-indegines living or doing businesses in Obiuno Community on the one hand and Obiuno leadership on the other. So far this is awesome in both effect and actual day to day interactions by all. The warm and cordial relationship with the Aloe Cabinet of Obiuno Igbo-Ukwu remains second to none.

Examples:

The happy and peaceful life lived by the late High Chief FOU Okiche, his demise and final rites of passage as shown to the family by Ndi Obiuno Community is a pointer to this Culture of Honours.

Other examples abound particularly with Honours shown to Prince Sam Ezeugonna Ezeifeka and Sir Mark Akwas Okoye as ex-Chairman during their burials are also further eloquent examples. Homage and official condolences to countless bereaved Families by Ndi Obiuno Community stand on good records during this Administration. May the souls of our departed rest in peace Amen

The EZE-AKAJIUGO led-Administration did not lose sight of the tremendous youths' resources in the community. This is being harnessed through youths sports and development. The Obiuno United Football Club and partnership with budding music artists, writers and the IYC have proven effective windows of joy and happiness to all the Stakeholders.

The women wing of Obiuno is always there for the community. The Ahiagu Market was revamped and resuscitated in 2018 to reduce the constant stress to our women who always hustle up and down to Nkwor Igbo Market as a matter of routine. At least, some cash crops and quick delicacies can be picked up today at our early



4 GOLDEN YEARS OF OBIUNO COMMUNITYUNDER EZEAKAJIUGO

CHAPTER 1

In the beginning....restoring people's confidence in community leadership was our first giant step: Join us as we take a walk down memory lane post-December 28, 2016 upon assuming office-:

As a leadership, we came to the service of Ndi Obiuno Community on the 28th of December, 2016 completely charged, burning with a vision and passion to succeed and therefore fully prepared to deliver superior leadership values and concrete results to Obiuno Quarter of Igbo-Ukwu from Day One to our Last day in office! We vowed to raise the leadership bar above the ordinary feat or nominal union officers that litter the local and partisan landscape of most communities across our borders. We were thus determined from the onset to make our community a role model and a point of reference to all successive leaderships including other progressive communities around us! To this end, all our strategic action plans were contained in our ODU Leadership 2016-2020 Brochure captioned OBIUNO ARISE, an entry strategy document single-handedly produced and distributed free of charge to all Ndi Obiuno Community by the in-coming Chairman, Eze-Akajiugo Sir

Barrister MCK Ubah.

As soon as we were sworn into this office for a term of four years, from 28th December, 2016 to 28th December, 2020, the train of progress departed the station armed with our clearly articulated blueprint code-named ORIDS.

The first item on our strategic action plan was a plan couched around boosting our human relations, reconciliation and restoration of people confidence/interest in the already depleted community administration and leadership. This was a key strategy that formed the plank or the hinge around which all other plans would rotate. On the 2nd of January, 2017, we invited strategic stakeholders to a dinner party in the home of our chairman, The AkajiugoGraceVilla, to rob minds on our porous security apparatus as well as proffer solutions on the way forward. The dinner, tagged 'The Obiuno Maiden Security Dinner', was a huge success as issues germane to overhauling our internal security architecture were discussed and funds raised to take care of our security needs including recharging our Obiuno Vigilante Group. It was the outcome of this dinner that enabled us to re-kit, re-equip and refurbish our dilapidated 'Toyota Hilux Security Van', purchase and repair our motor-cycles as well as increase the number and salaries of members of the vigilante operatives. With our security challenges under our effective control and management, we moved on to other issues of pressing nature. The die was cast!

Next on the line was the restoration of the rural electricity power supply to Obiuno which was hitherto comatose. Some of our four installed transformers were bad as a result of serial vandalization over time for lack of use or power supply for years. A new OREC (Obiuno Rural

Electricity Committee) was put in place headed by an experienced PHCN staff and supported by another consummate community Leader as adviser to the Committee, the stage was set to clear all the mess militating and debilitating against the seamless supply/flow of power via our already entrenched bulk-metering bill payment arrangement with PHCN. This aspect of our community challenge was not an easy one to resolve on account of piled up arrears of accumulated bills but with our people's determination and unity of purpose, all hands were placed on deck to ensure that PHCN power supply was immediately restored to Ndi Obiuno at a time when the whole parts of Igbo-Ukwu had stagnated with a complete blackout over years preceding our arrival on the 28th of December, 2016.

From mid-2017 till date, power supply had not ceased in our part of Obiuno save during periods of sporadic power downtime/outage on account of huge equipment or other infrastructural installations/repairs at the PHCN mega power stations or power line damages along other connecting host/shared communities. However, non-payment and irregular payments for bills consumed by Ndi banyi remain major bulwarks against providing uninterrupted power supply which problem is a recurrent decimal in our power supply effort. It is our hope that our people would one day wake up to appreciate the beauty of bulk metering currently being managed as against the bare-faced involvement/intervention of the PHCN officials in direct power billings, collections and disconnections across our villages. May God see us through this!

Beyond ensuring regular power supply by PHCN to Obiuno community, we also embarked on aggressive power line distribution and connection across all interior parts of our community that were hitherto not connected to our rural electricity grids. In this regard, we assisted those parts of Obiuno not reached by PHCN Poles and wires many years long after most parts have been energized and powered. We provided the poles and technical know-how to ensure that they also enjoy the dividends of our pragmatic people-driven leadership. Other parts of the community who also lost their PHCN poles or other installations due to adverse weather conditions also received succor from our leadership. Along this connection, we remember some parts of Ihuofor, Ihumabiam, Umuechefu, CKSS/St Peters Church Road and Amaehulu/St Barnabas Church axis of Obiuno community as beneficiaries of intervention at one point or the other.

We must not also fail to extol the patriotic spirit of Sir Eddy Muoemenam who was always there for us (and has not stopped being there for us) in critical times of need particularly when our transformers fail us. We recall with gratitude the series of times he had helped repair or

rejuvenate our transformers particularly the one around his road junction. We also appreciate in very optimum degree the untiring effort of our OREC adviser, Hon Javis Adinmuo, JP and Chief Chris Okonkwo whose roles in electricity power supply and bills payment cannot be concluded without them. Also, we salute the Comrade Jude Okiche led Committee for its commitment to the Obiuno Electricity Power distributions and billings!

Our badly dilapidated rural roads and erosion menace became the next monster we must confront giving the worsening road conditions in Obiuno Community. We must submit upfront that Obiuno Quarter, because of the peculiar nature of her sloppy landscape and topography, remains the only Quarter that serves as the collection pools and corridor for all menacing floods that are rushing to escape or are being generated by and within all our neighboring communities of Ihite and Ngo to the effect that year in year out, Obiuno community road networks remain in perpetual bad shapes and at the mercy of her less-concerned Igbo-Ukwu stakeholders. This sad state of our roads was made worse by the waning leadership profile of our predecessors who left the roads and catchment pits in very deplorable conditions for over ten years running without a wink. Until our holistic interventions starting from late last year up till early this year, it is on record that over 99 catchment pits within Obiuno community were left without clearing them for about 10 years running to the effect that almost all the major roads and other intra-link roads were rendered impassable!

To the glory of God and thanks to our Works/Erosion Committee, we were to step in last year before the Yuletide Break to clean up all the catchment pits as well as rehabilitate the roads to very excellent state of use. We went extra mile to assist other villages including Umuechefu to fix their roads, such as the newly commissioned Chief FOU Okiche Road, to very high standards including cleaning up their catchment pits in order to contain or restrain the menacing floods that swallow our major roads.

As a progressive leadership, we did not fail in our duties to support and appreciate our patriotic brothers who single-handedly rehabilitate or deliver different qualities, degrees and maintenance of connecting link roads stretching into kilometers within their and across contiguous boundaries of villages in Obiuno and neighbourhoods communities including Sir Eddy Muoemenam, Engr Onuora Nnabugwu, Sr Okey Gossac Okoli, Sir Osondu Nnabugwu, Sir Onyeka Nnabugwu and Mr Umeanadu all from Umunono. Others included Mr Chizoba Ezeafulukwe and Nze Ezeagunaechemba Cletus Onyemenam both of Umuechufu and Nze Amb. Ohamadike Ezezinwanne Okoye of Ihuofor Villages, just to mention but a few.

We must not fail to mention, with maximum gratitude, the understanding and co-operation of the Parish Priest Fr. Kizitto, the leadership of the PCC under Hon. Bro Leo Ogbonnia and entire parishioners of St Patrick's Catholic Church, Obiuno Igbo-Ukwu in their strategic alliance with Obiuno leadership to adjust the already constructed church fence to make for a wider seamless easement/passage of both vehicular and human traffic beginning from the Ahiagu Market Junction down to or towards the Ide John Ofokaja junction. We must all recall the cumulative difficulties and pains posed by that axis of our community road over the years that many people naturally avoided the use of that road particularly during rainy seasons due to the overwhelming pools of stagnant floods and narrow lane. That jinx, as many local folks termed it, was finally broken by our leadership led by Eze-Akajikugo to the glory of God! We deeply appreciate our big brothers who also lent their heavy weights during the lobbying or negotiating process. We will continue to appreciate: Chief Dr. Chris Ezeh, Ugwumba Igbo-Ukwu, Chief Eric Nwobi, Okeide Igbo-Ukwu, Chief Chris Okonkwo, Akudo Igbo-Ukwu, Hon Javis PC Adinmuo, JP, Hon Bro. Leo Ogbonnia, Nze Umenyika Umeokoli, Mr Emeka Okonkwo, Majoy Jekwu Ofordum, Mr Emma Osunkwo, Mr Pius Odika, Mr Nnaji Udoye and his brother Mr Chigbo Okoye among others who played other background support to see the successful adjustment and expansion of that road to what we have today. This was another clear and eloquent demonstration in the power of unity and love for our community. May God's name be praised!

Talking about roads across Obiuno Community, it is indeed a tale of two cities...! Many sons of Obiuno community have at various times and places lent their hands to fix one bad portion of our failed roads or joined hands to erect concrete pavements or 'culvetts' to assist our community. We at this point remember the cash donation from Nze Sir Ezeudoka Mathew Okoye towards the erection of the culvett at the Obiuno Health Centre in the early life of this administration as well as that volunteer work by Mayor Jekwu Ofordum for the repair of the failed portions of our newly constructed tarred Nkwor Market/Ekwulu-Miri Road. Sir Engr Dom Okafor, Hon Javis Adinmuo, JP as well as Engr Goddy Umeobiekwe are also part of our maintenance ambassadors at their own respective parts of their villages for which we express our profound appreciation.

First permit me to take you back to our point of entry on 28th December, 2016 through to our epochal December 2018 Mass Return Celebration. I had wished this Mass Return celebration became 'a festival of every four years for all Ndi Obiuno Quarter!'

CHAPTER 2

Setting the Road Map & Strategic Agenda.....

Ndi banyi, Our Obiuno Community under the last four years has witnessed massive transformation and exponential leap in infrastructural development from where we were years before the 28th December, 2016 to where we are today spread across all sectors of our community life and in all performance parameters. Following our 10-Point Strategic Agenda and Action Plan as contained on page 8 of our entry Brochure OBIUNO ARISE, we, as a leadership, propounded a development and transformation acronym OIRDS, Obiuno Integrated Rural Development Strategy, to guide our drive and focus within the four years constitutionally assigned to us as our tenure under the Obiuno Development Union Constitution. Armed with OIRDS in our hands as a development toolkit, blueprint or master plan, we then hit the road trusting in God Almighty for his navigational grace, power and provisions all through the journey ahead of us and beyond! May He be praised, Amen!

Two major sectors received the most massive and remarkable legacies of a lifetime, aside rekindling people trust and confidence in community leadership namely: provision of social infrastructure and healthcare delivery. Following our huge success during our December 28, 2018 Mass Return Celebration and in keeping with the promise made earlier to Ndi Obiuno on Day One, we set out to build the multi-million naira Obiuno Mega Civic Centre on the one part and our embarkation on fervent prayers to empower our donors in the building of the pledged Memorial Nnabugwu Cottage Health Centre (including Rehabilitation of the existing structures including drilling of a mega water borehole facility and medical equipments). These two projects took off simultaneously as concrete dividends of our Dec 28, 2018 Mass Return Celebrations even though funded under separate arrangements.

The Obiuno Mega Civic Centre is a direct funding from the assemblage of all financial and material resources donated or pledged to the Community during the Mass Return Celebration by various people of Obiuno including their friends from other communities, politicians alike. This is the 2-Storey multi-purpose Hall located behind the present Ahiagu Secretariat which projected completion cost is N100m. This is part of the legacies and gifts we seek to bequeath to our succeeding generations by all of us after enjoying them ourselves in our own life times! To God be the glory that these are both dream and vision come true! The Hall Project Committee is ably led by the foremost astute business mogul and philanthropist, Ebekuodike Sir Eddy Muoemenam and supported by a team of strong stakeholders and village chairmen.

The Obiuno Health Centre is another sector that has received a very significant attention and boost from our administration. Apart from the ongoing constructions and rehabilitations by the Nnabugwu sons, the health centre is one which is being managed by a competent health committee ably led by a healthcare expert and academic, Professor Innocent Igwilo. The centre is being run and managed by a crew of medical personnel led by an experienced resident nurse and others on a day to day basis. This community health facility remains one sensitive area which has received significant attention and donations from our well-meaning sons and daughters during this period of our four years. For example, some medical equipment have been donated to the centre in the past by both private and corporate persons including Mr Chike & Mrs Ijeoma Okafor of Connecticut, USA, among others before the intervention of the Nnabugwu sons. It is our hope and joy that the health centre will not escape the radar or navigational compass of the succeeding administration.

(January, 2017 – December, 2019)

Ndi banyi ekeneem unu! The Alor 1 Cabinet of Obiuno Igbo-Ukwu! Highly esteemed members of the Merit Chiefs' Council!

Our Villages/ Wards Chairmen of Obiuno Igbo-Ukwu! The great people and stakeholders of Obiuno Igbo-Ukwu! Nkeonye chiri, ya zelu! Distinguished people of Obiuno Igbo-Ukwu! Merry Christmas and a prosperous New Year to every one!



The past three years have been greatly remarkable in the lives of our people in all the areas of our community life particularly rural electricity power supply, healthcare delivery, security, roads maintenance and rehabilitation, social infrastructural development, inter-family interaction and intra-community bonding. When we came into office as the current executives of Obiuno Development Union, ODU, on December 28, 2016, we inherited a flaccid community, a community that was low-spirited in its outlook, a community that had lost hope in the capacity and ability of its elected leadership to deliver superior results! We saw a community that was at the threshold of giving up on itself and about to resign itself to destiny and a community that had suffered a waning and sapped confidence profile in the past community leadership in all measurement indices.

We embarked on prioritized goal setting and strategic framework to restore hope and confidence in ourselves as a community as well as our capacity and ability to deliver on mandate.We began some kind of aggressive consultation with our key stakeholders and development partners in Obiuno and ran on a people-driven agenda! We identified our major needs as a community and confronted the monsters headlong!

The following key areas of our community needs become our major focus areas namely: security, Rural Electricity power supply, roads rehabilitations and maintenance, healthcare, infrastructural development, community bonding and culture of honours.

On the 2nd of January 2017, we organized a security summit to overhaul our entire security architecture and reposition our OBIUNOVIGILANTE SQUAD to meet with the challenges of an evolving community, a community rapidly being overwhelmed by migrants of majorly artisan profile! We refurbished our Security Hilux Truck that was abandoned to decay by the past regime. We re-equipped our security team, donated some modern security kits, motorcycles, and increased the numbers of our security men with increased salary.We Vigilante Team became the Squad to beat in the whole of Igbo-Ukwu even as the entire town had lost its central security to the PG crises that engulfed the entire town. Obiuno Security became the one to rely on by our neighbors. Till date our security team has never wavered! We are proud of them!

When we came into office, rural electricity supply was comatose! Darkness engulfed the whole town and Obiuno was worse hit! For two to three years running, Obiuno was in complete darkness with dilapidated transformers. We took on electricity power supply with limitless vigor and passion because our happiness and economy depended on it. A few months down the line in 2017, electricity power supply returned to all the parts of Obiuno while the rest of Igbo-Ukwu remained largely in darkness.

We paid so much for it! Our bright sons of Obiuno put in their energies and with their high social contact, light returned to Obiun again and since then Obiuno has continued to enjoy regular power supply and if for any technical faults to disrupt supply, it wouldn't take ages to fix.

We took our community and family bonding very seriously. For 15 years after the last Obiuno Mass Return Celebration, no other such celebration had taken place and our people sojourned in foreign lands bearing children and marrying wives that their kinsfolk did not get to know. The idea of Obiuno Mass Return was muted to take place the following year, December 2018. And behold it became a huge success. The planning, organization and execution were such that till today, the ripples are vet to settle. Kudos to all the members of that MASS RETURN PLANNING COMMITTEE! Both the chairman, Sir Martin Ezeafulukwe, KSJII, Jp, and his Vice, Hon Javis Pius Adinmuo, JP, alongside the Assist. Secretary, Mr Okwy Umewenike (who for most part stood in for Hon Bro. Leo Ogbonnaya the substantive Committee's Secretary) gave their all. I cannot thank them enough! The outcome of that Mass Return was the building of THE OBIUNO MEGA CIVIC CENTRE, at Ahiagu Obiuno. The details of what happened and the donations made and realized during the December 28, 2018 Mass Return Celebration are annexed to our Annual Financial Report attached herewith.

THE OBIUNO MEGA CIVIC CENTRE is both a story and a project that cannot be told in one day! From the setting up of the Hall Project Committee to its design and construction were all by divine inspiration! It is indeed a God's Project. The Ground-Breaking for the Hall Project which took place during the Easter period of this year was itself another miracle altogether!

The actual construction of this Mega Civic Centre started in May 2019 and less than six months down the line, the Hall is headed to the decking of the second floor! I can only thank the Hall Project Committee ably chaired by no less a personality as Ebekuodike Sir Eddy Muoemenam with the 1stVice Chairman of ODU as the secretary. The Committee appointed one of own tested contractors to hand the project. The full Report of this Committee shall be presented to us by this time next year while a bird's eye-view can be presented to us if the committee is ready for that. The EXCO of ODU receives its periodic report from time to time and we can assure you that they are spectacularly on track.

In the area of Healthcare delivery in Obiuno Community, our primary healthcare Centre at Ahiagu is doing well. The Staff Nurse and her team of other nurses are responsive and responsible. Our Health Committee team is upbeat and doing well. Periodic health and medical missions visitations do take place at that centre from time to time. The boost and the icing on the cake for this centre is the intervention effort of the Nnabugwu sons led by the scion of that great family, Engr Onuora NNabugwu, Oduigboejeogu! During our December 28 2018 Mass Return Celebration, the Nnabugwu sons donated a whooping N50m towards the rehabilitation of that health centre. Today a water borehole has been sunk in that centre to support that centre and assist its construction efforts. We were informed by the donors that some consignment of medical supplies and equipment are already imported into the country in strategic readiness for the new structure and ongoing rehabilitation effort. May we continue in prayers for the successful completion of both the Mega Civic Centre and the Health Centre facility.

Our Roads rehabilitation programme is on course in both

our inner village roads and major roads. Today the Odozi Obodo – Umeanadu to Ahiagu down to Agu Ekpili axis of our major road is wearing a new look courtey ofour Works and erosion Committee. Though paucity of funds remains our major challenge but we are focused in ensuring that our people enjoy a seamlessYuletide and NewYear this time around!

Today, we are happy to say that despite some critical challenges and limitations, Obiuno is working.
