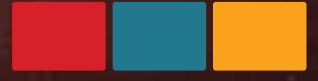

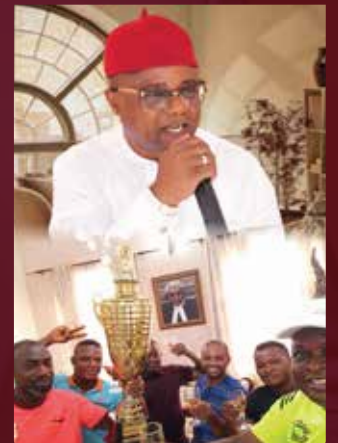

OF THE 1ST IDU GENERAL MEETING OF EZE-AKAJIUGO SIR DR MCK UBAH ADMINISTRATION: THE EPOCHAL DAWN OF A NEW ERA IN IGBO-UKWU.



The taste of the pudding, they say, is in the eating! This is because yesterday's meeting was better experienced than imagined:

IGBO-UKWU HAS NOT SEEN ANYTHING YET OF SUCH FROM ANY OF THE PREVIOUS ADMINISTRATIONS IN THE NATURE AND MODE OF AN ONLINE-REAL- TIME MEETING!

Prior to the meeting, the IDU Executives met on Friday 23/2/24 and properly streamlined the agenda for the meeting which made the rhythmic cadence of the meeting proceedings very seamless and a diaphanous reflection of the revived kindred Spirit in Igbo-Ukwu. My God, you needed to be there, at least as an observer because observers were properly received, recognized and well treated to delicious meals and drinks like all the other delegates and stakeholders.

The ambiance of the meeting venue (Amaehulu Town Hall) was best captured by Chief Chris Okonkwo, Akudo Igboekwu as a parliamentary setting, typical of his days in the 'Senate!' Hahaha! You know his early

days Guy name is Senator Topher...the late Okwadike Igbo-Ukwu used to greet him as "Distinguished", referring to his "Senator" Guy name! Hahaha

Ndi banyi, It's no longer news that the Amaehulu hall has been refurbished, the real news is that the meeting witnessed a new and better sitting arrangement with a state of the art superlative decorations, supervised by the 2nd Vice PG of IDU, Hon Ebere Bodos Obodoekwe, who is an Event Planner and Entrepreneur of good reputation!

The attendance to the meeting was quite exceptional as all the wards in Igboekwu were duly represented and almost all the branches of the IDU were present at the meeting. This is unprecedented in IDU's recent history epitomizing people's high hopes, expectations, warm enthusiasm and rejuvenated kindred spirit! Igbo-Ukwu is now on the march again!

You needed to witness the refreshing opening prayers by no less a quintessential Man of God, Arc Okey Ezech

who is the Chairman of the IDU Spiritual Life Development Committee as well as the distinguished President of the bespoke Concerned Igbo-Ukwu Citizens, CIC. Of spectacular mentioned was the grand entry of HRH Igwe Alex Ejikemeuwa Azike, Idu 3 of Igbo-Ukwu and his Cabinet Members. They were warmly received at the entrance Gate and welcomed by the Chief Host and presiding officer of the day's meeting, Eze-Akajiugo Sir Dr MCK Ubah, the PG of IDU.

All our Traditional Quarter Chiefs also enjoyed a grand entry. They were all present...all! Chief Sir Onyekachi Nnabugwu, Ume-Okpataozuora and Alor 2 of Igbo-Ukwu, Chief Sir Engr Nnamdi Ifeakor, Ezechinyelugo and Odu 3 of Igbo-Ukwu and Chief Sir Mike Nduka, Oji 3 of Igbo-Ukwu. It was a meeting like no other before!

After the usual reading, corrections and adoption of the minutes of the previous meeting came the metronomic centerpiece of the of the meeting which is the Unveiling of the 1st ever IDU ADMINISTRATION AND LEAD-

ERSHIP BROCHURE (2023-2027) TITLED "THE STRATEGY AND ACTION PLAN FOR MOVING IGBO-UKWU FORWARD BEYOND THE NEXT FOUR (4) YEARS", a 100 page digitally printed document powered and presented by Eze-Akajiugo Sir Dr MCK Ubah led- Administration (Ohazulume) of Igbo-Ukwu Development Union. It was indeed a historic moment for Igbo-Ukwu!

Apart from clearly outlining development plans for Igbo-Ukwu over the next 4 year, it also contains beautiful memories in living colors of who is who in Igbo-Ukwu. It's of paramount importance that every indigene of Igbo-Ukwu must try to grab a personal copy of that colorful Brochure to be plausible in all the affair of Igbo-Ukwu over the next four years. Copies are available @ IDU branches nationwide, IDU wards (1-36) and IDU Secretariat.

The Unveiling of the Brochure equally served as a fundraiser for IDU as almost every one present launched it with various amounts of money. The finance team of IDU will present that report separately in due time.

After the launching, few available Committee's reports were presented to IDU and various new committees Inaugurated. Most notable among the committees Inaugurated is Conflict & Community Vexatious Issues Resolution Committee headed by Hon O.C Gaius Ezeh because immediately after their inauguration, the Alor 2 of Igbo-Ukwu and the President General Respectively lamented bitterly about the poor handling of the sharing of rice meant for the widows in our community and mandated the committee to immediately swing into action, starting from investigating, interrogating of the entire process of the rice sharing, report their findings and recommend appropriate action to any indicted person. However it was resolved that all the rice that went into the wrong hands must be recovered. Anybody that is not a widow that has opened her own must have to buy and

replace it.

The details of other committees inaugurated will be presented separately to avoid making this too lengthy.

Enough refreshments were made available for the attendees; the food menu included Rice with ofe-akwụ, anjga, ona, ede nghucha etc but that is not all. The meeting was held amidst joy, kindred spirit and happiness from beginning to the end. It was streamed online by a special team but the stream was put on hold when sensitive security matters were on the table of discourse.

THE CLIMATIC MOMENT OF THE WHOLE MEETING WAS THE HOSTING OF ALL STAKEHOLDERS PRESENT IN HONOR OF THE PRESIDENT-GENERAL OF IDU, EZE-AKAJIUGO SIR DR MCK UBAH BY HIS BROTHER AND BOSOM FRIEND, WHO IS THE PRESIDENT OF AMIR GROUP, EZE-AGUNECHEMBA CLETUS ONYEMENAM IN HIS PALATIAL RESIDENCE!

His palatial residence is within a walking distance away from the IDU Hall. According to him, he decided to host all the stakeholders in honor of the President-General as a way of contributing in the revival of the Kindred Spirit in Igbo-Ukwu and a pledge of unalloyed fraternal love, Solidarity and Support to the Eze-Akajiugo led "Ohazulume Administration". He encouraged all the stakeholders to bury their hatchets and embrace the progressive leadership of Eze-Akajiugo maka Odinma Igbo-Ukwu. The hosting was really memorable and worth writing home about.

Immediately after that, the President-General, in company of some stakeholders proceeded on a courtesy visit to Cheif Luke Ezekafor Ezike (EZE-AGUNAECHEMBA) of Ihuakaba Igbo-Ukwu who lost his wife recently and could not be present at the meeting as a result of that. Eze-Agunечи-

be was very happy that IDU remembered him in his moment of grief and prayed for the progress and unity of Igbo-Ukwu

Another significant Mileage coverage yesterday toward the restoration of Peace and Unity in Igbo-Ukwu was another courtesy visit to one of the leading centenarians, Ide Sir JNC Ezeife. Ide Ezife is the oldest Ide in Igbo-Ukwu and the leader of the G17 faction of the Idu Cabinet that is in Court. The President-General pleaded with him to assist in the resolution of the impasse in the Idu Cabinet of Igbo-Ukwu since we now have a new Idu 3 who is God-given and generally accepted to the 3 quarters of Igbo-Ukwu.

In response, he promised to meet with others and chat a way forward even as a final date was fixed by the court to deliver judgment on that pending matter. He said 3rd and 9th April remain the court dates.

It all ended in praises yesterday as Igbo-Ukwu is inevitably on the march to greatness again.

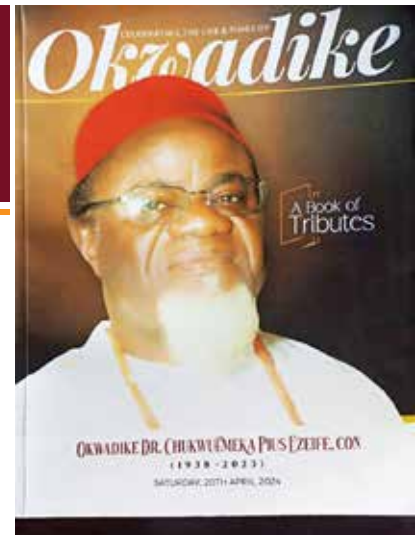

GOES HOME

CELEBRATING THE ICONIC RISE FROM A MOTOR SPARE PARTS APPRENTICE TO Ph.D HOLDER IN ECONOMIC FROM HAVARD UNIVERSITY AND EXIT OF ONE THE GREATEST IGBO-UKWU ICON. CHIEF PIUS CHUKWUEMEKA EZEIFE (OKWADIKE NDI IGBO)



Reminiscing about the demise of His Excellency Okwadike Dr. Chukwuemeka Ezeife, one might easily think of the great philosopher Epicurus. The great thinker made this statement on the marble: "Against all else, it is possible to provide security, but as against death, all of us mortals alike dwell in an unfortified city.

Death is indeed an inevitable end that must come when it must come. In his magnum opus, *The City of God*, one of the Doctors of the Church (Catholicism), St. Augustine, pointed out how death is inevitable. He said,

"For no sooner than we begin to live in this dying body than we begin to move ceaselessly towards death. For in the whole course of this life (if life is what we must call it), its mutability tends towards death. Our whole life is nothing but a race towards death.

- Born on the 20th of November 1938 to late Mr Joshua and Virginia Ezeife in the ancient Archeological town in Igbo-Ukwu. Young Chukwuemeka began his primary education at the Salvation Army Primary School but completed it at the Holy trinity CMS Primary School.

- On completion of his Primary Education in 1952, he went for apprenticeship under a motor spare parts trader in Aba but could not stay bc of his love and zeal for Education.

- He came back to Igbo-Ukwu and picked up a teaching career at Salvation Army Primary School Igbo-Ukwu.
- Shortly after, he proceeded to Teachers Training College Akai in Eket.
- After that he continued with his teaching career and at the age of 22, he became a Primary School headmaster in Osumenyi town.



- While he was teaching he used his free time to take correspondence courses from Rapid Result London and 2 respective years after he took and passed the Cambridge General Certificate of Education (GCE) both Ordinary and Advanced level.
- He was admitted into the university of Ibadan in 1961 and graduated in with a second class honors in Economics in 1964.
- He worked briefly with the Nigeria Breweries PLC before entering the Nigerian Federal Civil service which took him to many local and international trainings.
- In 1967 while on a Leadership training program at Arthur D. Little Company, United States of America, the Nigeria-Biafra war broke out a he became a refugee.
- After the training, he could not come back to Nigeria because of the ongoing war, he proceeded Uganda, where he took up an Economic lecturing Appointment with Makerere University.
- Subsequently, With the help of a Rockefeller Foundation Scholarship, he obtained a Doctorate degree in Economics from Harvard University
- The war ended in 1970 but he could not come back immediately because of the programs he had running and by 1972 he had obtain both his Masters and Ph.D in Economics.

- He came to Nigeria and returned to the Nigerian Federal Civil Service, where he rose to the rank of a Director in the Federal Ministry of Planning and Economic Development and subsequently became the permanent Secretary of the Ministry.
- He held many high and influential positions in the Federal Civil as a mater of Fact, at a certain point, he was the secretary of a committee granting specifically licenses to producers for the importation of raw materials and equipment into Nigeria. Oh what a stupendous height to behold.
- In 1986, He retired from civil service having reached the pinnacle of success in the Civil service and ventured into commerce and politics.
- He opened an import-export business, exporting Agricultural product like cashews.
- In January 1992, he was elected and sworn in as the first executive Governor of Anambra State.
- He left office in June 1993 as a result of the annulment of Chief MKO Abiolas election and the crises that followed which went out of control, the military intervened.
- He went back to lagos and continued with his import-export business
- He served as special adviser to President Olusegun Obasanjo.

- In 2002/2003 he had a brief run for the President of the Federal Republic of Nigeria under the Social Democratic Party (SDP).
- Dr. Chukwuemeka Pius Ezeife, Okwadike Igbo Ukwu, passed away at the Federal Medical Centre Abuja on Thursday, December 14, 2023, at the ripe age of 86.
- On December 15, 2023, Ezeife's family announced his passing.
- On February 8 2024, in Abuja, the national burial committee was officially inaugurated by Rt. Honourable Benjamin Kalu, the deputy speaker of the House of Representatives. Okwesilieze Nwodo, a former governor of Enugu State, was chosen to lead Chukwuemeka Ezeife's national burial committee.
- The star-studded national burial committee of the late sage consists of former governors, legislators, captains of industries, and elder statesmen of various social-cultural groups, faith-based organisations, political parties, and civil society groups across the country.
- The deputy speaker, who presided over the committee's official inauguration, tasked the Nwodo-led group with ensuring that the late Ezeife received a fitting send-off. He also promised the assistance of the national assembly members. Deputy Speaker Kalu remarked at the time, "Ezeife



was a great man who sacrificed for the Igbo tribe. He believed in a south-east of peace and unity. He did not stand for the killing and destruction some people are carrying out in the region now. He also believed in dialogue and the spirit of oneness. So, we will use his burial to tell Nigerians that Igbo people are united. Indeed, Ezeife lived a long and healthy life until his final hour.

- It was a week-long celebration of the life and time of Okwadike Chukwuemeka Ezeife, and he took the final bow, leaving the stage.

- There was a Service of Songs and a carnival to honour cum kick off his final

earthly journey back to his creator on April 12 in Eagle Square, Abuja.

- On April 19, the Anambra state government conducted his state burial in Awka.

- On April 20 2024, he was interred and given an Igbo burial in his hometown of Igbo Ukwu.

- On April 21 2024, there was a Thanksgiving service in Igbo Ukwu at the Salvation Army Church.

In all these Celebrations of life that marked his Iconic exist, The 'OHAZULUME' leadership of Igbo-Ukwu Development Union led by Eze-Akajiugo Sir Dr MCK Ubah duely participated in the whole

event.

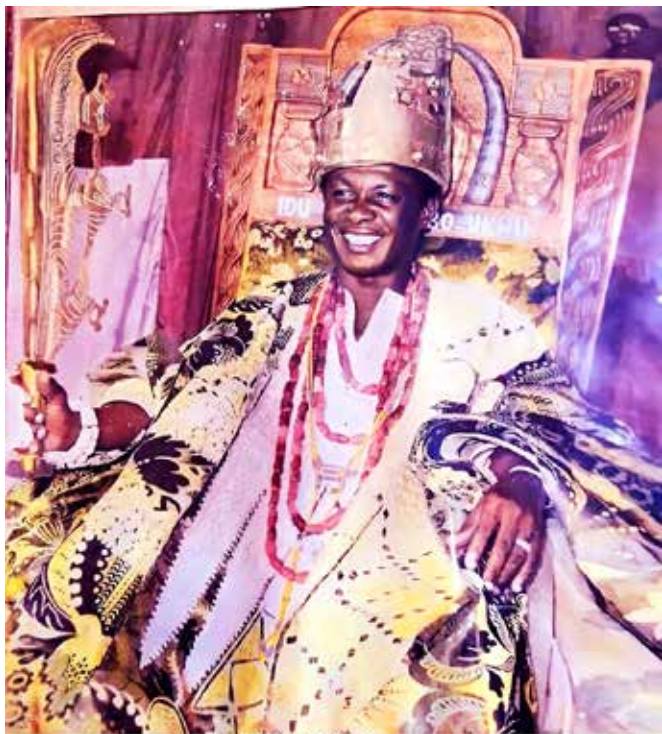

It's often said that times are changing fast ... Oh yeah, of necessity, times must change! Our prayers must be that the changing times must be for good...maka odinma Igbo-Ukwu! Indeed Team Eze-Akajiugo symbolizes that good feeling of positive changes in Igbo-Ukwu! The signs are evident everywhere you go!

What are those positive changes at our Amaehulu Town Hall since the inception of Team Eze-Akajiugo on the 30th of December, 2023?

The other good news is that our Royal Fathers today no longer sit on common plastic chairs during IDU Meetings but they now have a royally-built or customized-chairs made only for kings and revered Chiefs! Indeed

Igbo-Ukwu deserves the best as a community renowned for its centuries of bespoke archeological artifacts evidencing a rich ancient tradition of great civilization. Directly sitting adjacent the Idu Cabinet is the prestigious members of the Nze N'Ozo Igbo-Ukwu who for the first time in history have now been accredited to sit as a group of distinguished folks at Amaehulu Town Hall. Directly sitting opposite the Idu Cabinet of Igbo-Ukwu is yet another revered group: Igbo-Ukwu Merit Chiefs Council. Other structured groups are the Quarter Chairmen who now sit together with their 36 Wards Chairmen in one respected roll. Beside them are the Branches Chairmen and or representatives. We also have a special roll of honor for the bespoke Igbo-Ukwu Stakeholders and other strategic IDU development partners. Finally we have a reserved corner for IDU Observers and accredited visitors. These sitting arrangements are properly marked and labeled with the names of each group or participants. Bye bye to ghost meeting attendants. Your presence must count as you're being accredited.

2. For the first time years, IDU Meetings are now held in a properly lit up meeting Hall where fans are green energy-powered bulbs make for enlightened illumination and brightness! The days of touch lights from cell phones to read Minutes of Meetings or other documents are over. Fraternal Greetings to all!

On behalf of our President-General of IDU, Eze-Akajiugo Sir Dr MCK Ubah, Esq, it's with great delight and honor that I write this special presentation to you of our first 54 days in office to showcase our stewardship scorecard over the past 54 days of coming to the IDU Central Administration as your elected officers.

The "OHAZULUME" Administration of Eze-Akajiugo came on board on the 30th of December, 2023 after the declaration of election results and swearing in as IDU officers that would serve you in the next four years. And we are happy to report that upon the sound of the whistle, we set out for the great marathon race in the service of our people and dear community!

- On the 4th January, 2023, we held a formal but brief HANOVER meeting with the past administration at the IDU Secretariat. We could not complete the critical process of changing the signatories to the bank accounts of IDU on that day but we decided to proceed to work with our personal funds pending the time bank issues are sorted out which have not even happened up till this date.

- Sadly, we discovered upon receiving the keys to both the IDU Hall at Amaehulu Town Hall and the IDU Secretariat at the Post Office Block were in very poor and dilapidated conditions and as such not conducive for meetings and proper Secretarial works.

- We invited experts to review their general statuses including electrical works, plumbing facilities and office equipment but their findings were shocking. Electrical

wirings had been vandalized and ceiling cables stolen. All the ceiling fans were stiff and bulbs and general lightens were not there.

- We immediately embarked on general repairs, rewiring, cleaning, fumigation and refurbishing of both the IDU Secretariat and the IDU Hall simultaneously to make for quality human occupation and use.

- Beginning with God: On the 17th of January, 2024, we invited our most senior Priests of God from both the Anglican and Roman Catholic Communities of Igbo-Ukwu to help dedicate our refurbished IDU Secretarial Office at the back of the Igbo-Ukwu Post Office Block, Nkwor Igbo Market Igbo-Ukwu and therefore handed over our Administration and the entire affairs of Igbo-Ukwu Development Union under the watch of Eze-Akajiugo to the Almighty God.

- To say the least, the office was practically transformed into a digital one, with the complete rewiring of the office, installation of ceiling fans, air-conditioners, the installation of office computers, printers, photocopy machine and other office gadgets. None of these basic office equipments were there in the first place.

- By the same 17th of January, we were able to completely refurbish the IDU Hall at Amaehulu in readiness for the first ever IDU Leadership Roundtable Training which we had proposed to undertake as a foundational task of building our leadership capacities, skill set and appropriate mindset.

- It's worthy of note that our IDU Hall was seriously vandalized but we were able to restore the vandalized Hall to a very conducive meeting atmosphere as well as put in place adequate security measures to prevent further future vandalization to the admiration of all.

- Immediately after the office dedication prayers and counseling by the priest were over, we went into the 1st Executive Meeting of IDU elected officers inside the now digitalized IDU Secretariat.

At the Executive Meeting, we resolved that in the spirit of 'Anyi bu Ofu' and continuity of a seamless administration of

IDU affairs, we considered it expedient to retain or preserve all the existing IDU Committees (both Standing and ad-hoc) as well as all their members which we inherited from the past administration and to encourage them to continue with their services until our February Meeting during which time we will have enough time to study their performances.

- On the 18th and 19th of January, 2024, we began and successfully organized or executed the first ever IDU Leadership Roundtable Training Workshop for all our elected Officers of IDU, the Quarter and Ward Chairmen and Secretaries and branches' Representatives across the country including the IDU Women Wing or Representatives. The Youths of Igbo-Ukwu in general were not left out including the Idu Cabinet members and Quarters' Chiefs.

- The leadership training was a huge success and very impacting especially with an impressive turn out of our Youths' segment of Igbo-Ukwu.

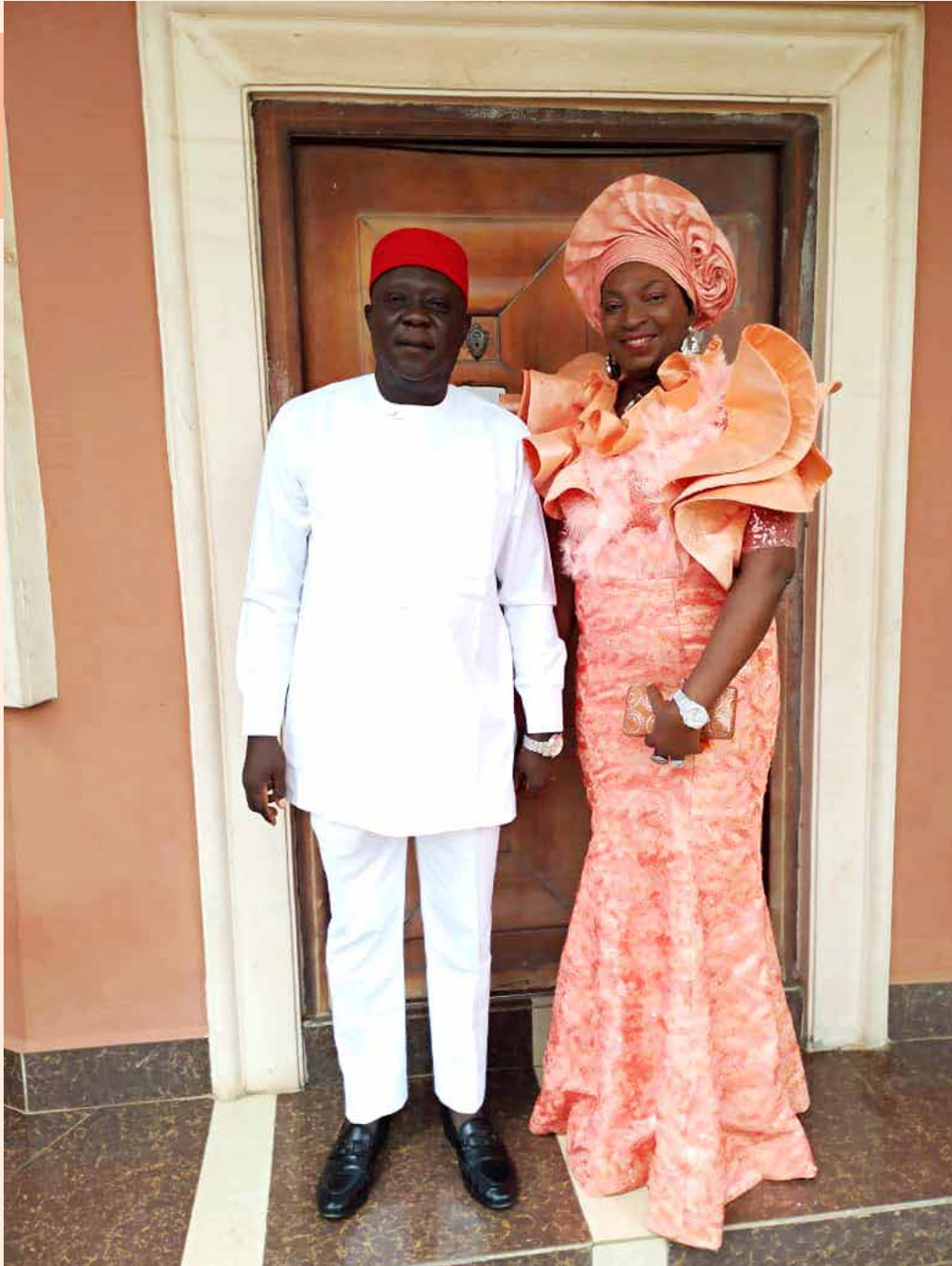

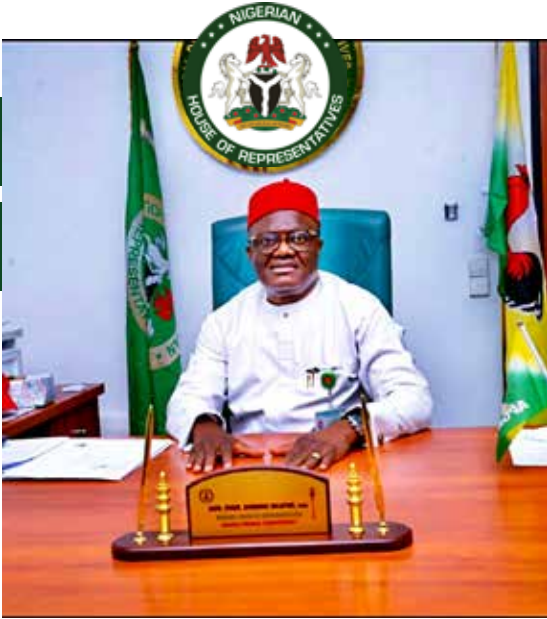

IGBO-UKWU: YOUTHS & SPORTS

A BRIEF HISTORY OF IGBO-UKWU FOOTBALL ASSOCIATION (IFA), THE MOTHER OF ALL SPORTS IN IGBO-UKWU.



According to the Book titled "Igbo-ukwu in Sports" written by Emeka Igwilo and published in 1995, there is no record to ascertain how and when sport event started in Igbo-Ukwu, however, the available record shows the history dated to the early days of traditional wrestling which is as old as the town.

The author continued that 'On the history of the modern games, the record shows that entertainment practices have been going on in various events until the middle of forties when association known then as Igbo-ukwu Youths Association (IYA) developed interest and organized inter-town friendly soccer competitions with some neighboring towns like Amichi, Nanka, Isuofia, Adazi and Awka-Etiti.

The friendly competitions which always took place during the Christmas period went on for many years until 1956 when the association collapsed after accomplishing her postal agency project.

The collapse of IYA gave room to the formation of teams in the Igbo-Ukwu Progressive Union (IPU) branches. Thus Chief Mike Azike, Mr Willy Mbanefo and late Mr Bertrand Onuzulike organized a team in Onitsha and contacted late Mr Ben Ikegwuonu (Tropic Ben) who also formed his own football team at Port Harcourt in 1957. The two teams continued playing inter-branch friendly matches until 1958 when Mr. Joachim Ume (Okafor Aba) produced his own team at Aba in the same development. Mr. Stephen Nwosu (Nwakpiagu) in 1959 formed his own team known then as Amateur Soccer Club of Home Branch made up of teachers and students

With the aim to regenerate the glorious Christmas soccer festival, the writer stated that the aforementioned teams assembled and wrote a letter to late Chief Festus Okoli Onyekwelu for financial assistance to enable them organize the 1959 competition, the late Chief accepted the request but instead of

giving the financial help he donated a small silver cup with a winning prize of one pound one shilling (two naira ten kobo) with the utmost aim of promoting peace and unity among the indigenes through sports. This gesture immediately inspired the teams to form a soccer ruling body known as Igbo-ukwu Football Association (IFA) in 1959.

Above is the brief on how the Igbo-ukwu Football Association was born. This Association has not only stood strong as a formidable body, it has also proven its mettle as an admirable administrative organ that has also supported the growth of other sports. To ensure that the town enjoys the benefits of sports in every society.

Some of these benefits include using sports as a fulcrum to build unity, bonding and togetherness. Sports helps to improve mental health, emotional balance and fitness. Sports provides avenues for kids to make new friends, teamwork and develop leadership skills. Sports keeps youths busy, out of crime and social vices etc.

THE BIRTH OF EZEAKAJIUGO CUP (WOMEN FOOTBALL)



A fruitful session with the President General of IDU and the birth of Ezeakajugo Cup for Women Football

Some of the executive members of Igbo-ukwu Football Association (IFA) were privileged to have a meeting with the President General of Igbo-ukwu Development Union (IDU) to brief him on the activities of the football body. The session also gave opportunity for honest dialogue and issues to be laid bare, on how football and sports generally can be improved in Igbo-ukwu, for the community to take its proper place in the Sports Industry.

The visit was a formal interface after the inauguration of the current leadership of the Administrative organ of the Archaeological city. The 2nd day of March 2024 will ever remain indelible in the history of football in Igbo-ukwu as the day marked yet, another breakthrough in the effort to ignite the Women football competition as this will give opportunity for our indigenes to key into the global wave of women soccer.

The President General of IDU, Bar. Ezeakajugo MCK Ubah, wasted no time in honoring our request for the courtesy call since he was ever in the know of the power of soccer and what football and sports generally can do in the unification of any community. It is on record that Igbo-ukwu Football Association completely held firm and made sure that football activities were going on in the community in the days of the Iduship tussle and stalemates in battle for the position of the PG. The members of IFA were focused and never allowed the

Association to be dragged into the politics as they were aware that if the youths get entangled in the politics then the center can no more hold. Thank God that IFA was happy that there was no Christmas that football finals were not held. Instead, more competitions were introduced and youths were busy, focused and off the politics.

In the past, a visit to the President General (PG) of Igbo-ukwu used to be to solve a problem that emanated from the dispute or to seek for IDU's intervention on the use of one of the football pitches or the other. Effort to seek intervention through the town union, our mother body, always come up because of the way every leadership sees sports. Some see sports investment as a wasteful venture while others see it as a fiesta for the youths only. Yet, sports in today's world is a serious business, a theater for fruitful entertainment and a unifying activity. Needless to mention the health benefits of sports and the impact it has on keeping the youths out of social vices. Above all, Sports create a forum for building lasting and cohesive friendship.

Have you ever wondered why Igbo-ukwu community does not have a collective playing field? All the sporting activities of the community are either held at the school field or the Church premises/field. This is a big gap that needs to be filled and the effort of the Youths Social Club of Igbo-ukwu (with their Stadium project) is yet to be achieved. Readers of history will

remember that the non-availability of the Community Square or the town's playing field led to constant quarrel that came up in the community some years ago. Then, conflicts always emanated on issues of religious beliefs and the use of the venues for the Mmanwu festivals and otherwise. Thank God that a new understanding is leading to the harmonized atmosphere and marriage of convenience.

Have given us an early appointment, the delegates of IFA came as scheduled and on first dial of a call, the President General picked and opened the door for us, ready and dressed in simple and sporty attire to discuss with us. As always said, first impression always matters. Immediately I saw the PG in sportswear and not his usual Ozo Title Cap or Babariga, for Community functions, I knew he was prepared for us.

We barely finished our introduction, and as an orator, the PG entered the boxing arena and threw the first punch with his right hand as if he had a pipe into our requests, and dealt with one of the topics we were to discuss. When I looked at my fellow officials, I saw the smiles on their faces and I knew that the PG had decimated all of them with the beautiful uppercut. The following ideas later made up the bounty harvests with no one getting hurt:



Ways football can be reactivated to regain its clamor and gain more followership:

1. Branches to be urged to Participate especially in the December league as they help unite the youths of the Community.
2. IDU to make deliberate effort to budget and invest in Sport development through institutionalization of the Sport Grant to be given to the football body and for development of other sports.
3. Need for every Branch and Village Union to have a Sports Committee, the way IDU has.
4. IDU to recognize, encourage and appreciate Individuals that sponsor sports in the ancient city, as a way of boosting that industry.
5. Need for the Female Football to be remodeled to attract more followership as well as create avenues for social mix. It is on record both in the past and in the mid-80s that people used to go to 'Egwuon-wa' and Azudo to look for wives, that atmosphere needs to be created through a better and organized setting. IDU needs to have a deep dive in what makes the youths happy and make investment there.
6. IFA to boost their Media awareness to ignite the Commercial values of football.
7. Development and Penetration strategy to be deployed to capture more attention of people.

8. The 1st and 3rd January every year to be reserved as Igbo-ukwu Sports Days. This entails that effort will be made to streamline IDU Calendar to show that the Community is well organized and not controlled by non-state actors. In the past, Igbo-ukwu community used to harmonize their activities and get it well separated and programmed to avoid abuse.

Outside all the points discussed above, the issue that took the longest time in the dialogue was how Igbo-ukwu Community can give sports its rightful place and make Christmas activities more memorable, organized and seamless.

When the discussion came to the point to review Female Football as a way of carrying the Womenfolk along as they are already clamoring for, Bar. Ezeakajiugo took up the challenge and requested IFA to come up with proposal on that. This acceptance electrified the entire atmosphere and gave Birth to Ezeakajiugo Cup for Women Football. One could but only imagine the excitement of the footballers that visited Late Chief FO Onyekwelu in 1959, for support and left with the birth of F.O Onyekwelu Cup, which is still played every December, till date. Though Chief FO Onyekwelu (Ogbuefi Igbo-ukwu) is no more, His legacy still remains, flourishing and a pride of the Community. The foresight of Late Onyekwelu was what gave birth to the formation of Igbo-ukwu Football Association (IFA) in 1959 on which platform we visited the head of the Town Union.

The technical team of IFA is working out plans on the modalities and sponsorship package for the maiden edition come, 2025.

Details on the modalities will be released before the end of the year. This gives all the interested and physically fit girls a long notice to start preparation for the game.

Like Nostradamus, the man that saw tomorrow, no one would need a clairvoyant to tell him or her that Igbo-ukwu is growing into a hub for Sports tourism, and we must support it.

For those still waiting to join the ride, we advise you better come and partner IFA for the continued unification of the Igbo-ukwu youths through sports. If the Chairman of the Nigeria Football Federation (NCF) can visit Igbo-ukwu in December 2023 and if the IDU 111 of Igbo-ukwu, the Alor 11 and the Odu 111 with other dignitaries from home and in diaspora can be at Holy Trinity Church field for the finals of the Igbo-ukwu Premier League, it therefore means that we all need to join hands with the Town and the Football body to give our football a face lift.

This consequently shows that the glamour of the soccer embraces all the generations and gender in the society and we must not let the legacy die.

The Chairman of the age grade Chief Nelson Osunkwo presented the Congratulatory letter to the President-General and expressed unalloyed Fraternal support to

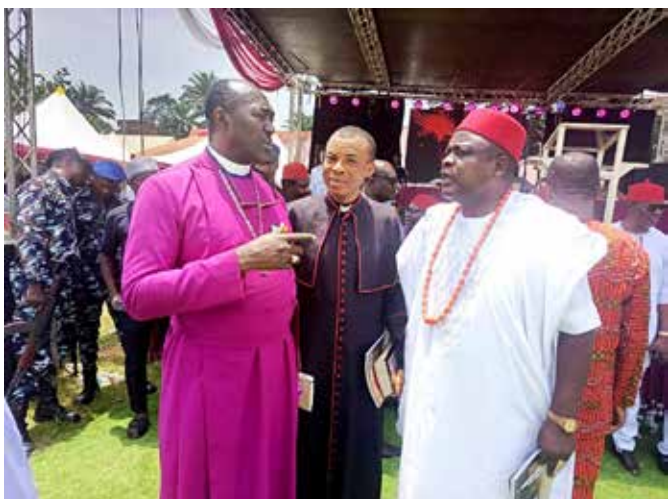
the administration of Eze-Akajiugo.

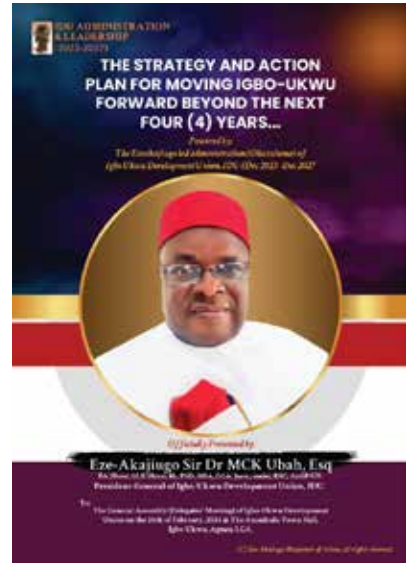

Handover and..... on the MOVE ...with this strategic document

After weeks of avoidable tension and intense political intrigues, there was a successful change of guards at Amaehulu on 3/12/23. Ezeakajiugo MCK Ubah, the man who appeared to have be set aside for a time like this, became the sole candidate and emerged as President General of IDU and NO1 citizen of Igbo-Ukwu in the next 4 years, God willing. He has hit the ground

running, setting up structures for an inclusive government, digitised the IDU office at Nkwo, upgraded the infrastructure and optics at Amaehulu, and organised the First IDU Leadership Development Roundtable in conjunction with the Center for Communal Leadership and Civic Education. The first general meeting on 24/2/24 was the most attended in recent years as well as the first online realtime meeting by the IgboUkwu community and

probably by any community in Anambra state. At the meeting he presented to Igbo-Ukwu community, a neatly published document titled the strategy and action plan for moving Igbo-Ukwu forwardbeyond the next four years. It contains the 15-point agenda of Team-Akajiugo, which includes restoration of hope, leadership skillset and mindset improvement, curbing mindless court litigations, runuing IDU meetings as a model for other

He also presented a three-point mission statement: to win back those who opposed his ambition,

deepen the trust of those who supported him, and fulfill Gods purpose for him in this generation, assuring that he would be fair, honest, faithful and transparent in their discharge.

His administration has also created most of his committees(mostlyrolled-over from the previous administration). There was also a reception for the new administrations by Ezeagunechemba Onyemenan. Having inherited a fractured polity, he had consciously reached out to many critical stakeholders, in an effort to mend fences

and bring everybody on board. His most recent activity was a special session with members of the Nkwo Market remodeling Committee, which was hosted by Chief Ezeh on 3/2/24, things are looking up and Igbo-Ukwu will be great again, even GREATER than before

We wish him well as we are watching his administration, especially vis-a-vis his espoused agenda and the Ohazulume philosophy.
