

Permit me to welcome you to Igbo-Ukwu using the transformational story of the once abandoned Obiuno Health Centre and other similar recent transformations in Igbo-Ukwu such as the two roads billed to be commissioned today as reference points. At the end of it all, I must behave like the fabled Oliver Twist who always asks for more

THE TRANSFORMATIONAL STORY OF THE NEW OBIUNO HEALTH CENTRE FACILITY, IGBO-UKWU AS POWERED BY THE GEORGINA NNABUGWU FOUNDATION (GNF)

Your Excellency,

Your Royal Highnesses, Ladies and gentlemen, today I make bold to say that it was the sheer candour and transformative spirit which always powers the children and promoters of the GEORGINA NNABUGWU FOUNDATION, GNF, that became fully manifested in the time-tested inspirational quote by Ella Wheeler Wilcox that "there is no force, chance, destiny, or fate that can hinder the firm resolve of a determined soul (or people)."

What we see here today seems to have summarized the long-galvanising force and dreams of the founding fathers of Obiuno Igbo-Ukwu to what is today known as the Obiuno Health Centre Facility, a dream come true courtesy of the children of late Ichie Ezeifesinachi Ephraim and Ezinne Georgina Nnabugwu under the aegis of the GEORGINA NNABUGWU FOUNDATION, GNF, a not-for-profit governmental organisation set up in honour and loving memory of their mother.

For the records and for those who do not know, the principal promoters or members of GNF are all the sons of the noble NNABUGWU DYNASTY of Obiuno Igbo-Ukwu notably: Engr Onuora Nnabugwu (Oduigboejeogu), Nze Sir Osondu Nnabugwu (Mmirienweilo), Nze Sir Arinze Nnabugwu, Chief Sir Onyeka Nnabugwu (Alor 2 of Igbo-Ukwu), Nze Sir Obiora Nnabugwu and Nze Sir Ifeanyi Nnabugwu). We must not also forget the fact that their late father, Ichie Ezeifesinachi Ephraim Nnabugwu, was a one-time chairman of Obiuno Quarter back in the years. Indeed, the entire people of Obiuno Quarter and Igbo-Ukwu as a whole are highly grateful as well as indebted to these patriotic sons of our land!

However, the vision to transform the once abandoned Obiuno Health Centre into a modern community hospital was first published in the widely acclaimed "2016-2020 Strategic Action Plan of the Obiuno Quarter Leadership" under the distinguished chairmanship of Eze-Akajiugo Sir Barr. MCK Ubah, who is today the President-Gen-

eral of Igbo-Ukwu. Happily this executive vision met its purpose, fertilisation and fruition in the virile hearts of the promoters of the GEORGI-NA NNABUGWU FOUNDATION, GNF, who quickly took it up and began to plan for its eventual execution by way of modernization, equipment and total transformation to what is now seen to be a first-in-class community health centre facility, east of the Lower Niger.

In the mandatory all-citizens' December 2018 Obiuno Mass Return Celebrations, the promoters of GNF announced a whooping take-off donation of fifty million naira (N50,000,000,000) for the start-up transformation of the Obiuno Health Centre, a rare feat that received thunderous ovations from the good people of Obiuno Quarter and beyond its shores

Consequently, this donation stimulated and compelled the executive leadership of Eze-Akajiugo to officially authorise GNF in writing to take over the complete modernization work of the entire health centre estate, namely: to erect more building structures, construct purpose-built medical blocks, landscaping of the hospital estate, sink potable water borehole, put up additional housing quatres for the medics/staff as well as provide medical equipments and drugs etc. Today from what we have on ground, GNF has exceeded its initial promise or mandate to achieve much more in order to completely beautify and make the Health Centre the envy of all. What a rare feat in this part of the world!

Again this awesome huge donation kept reverberating across the community till today even as it has become clear that what has been pumped into this project from that year till today by GNF is far in excess of three hundred and fifty million naira (N350,000,000.00), all for the love of community and humanity.

From what we have on ground today, this new Health Centre Facility can fit into any standard generic General Hospital by all measurement indices! What remains to be done today is for the Government of the day at the State Capital to make a policy pronouncement for its immediate upgrade to a State General Hospital status with all the requisite paraphernalia or credentials to match.

This transformation or upgrade by Mr Governor of Anambra State is what the new Obiuno Health Centre Facility earnestly needs now. Your Excellency, Olu-Atu-Egwu Ndi Igbo, the ball is now in your court!

Our people need to have and enjoy a functional health centre facility nearby. Only our Governor's stroke of his pen is all that remains: And as God said it earlierin the Creatiion's Story of the World: 'let there be light, And there was light!' We therefore count on today's special visit of His Excellency,

However, we will failing our people if we do not draw your attention to some other critical inter-towns feeder roads such as listed below:

- 1. Paul Ezeonu- Girls' Secondary School IgboUkwu down to Azigbo Town;
- 2. Etiti Village down to Ekwulu-Miri Town.
- 3. IgboUkwu-Aguluzigbo Road through to Umuona Town. These roads have earlier been captured in our various letters to your office through the Works Commissioner's Office.
- 4. Erosion Sites at Umudege Village bordering Ikenga Town and Boys' Secondary School Igbo-Ukwu
- 5. Erosion Sites at Ihuofor and Umunono Villages as aggravated by menacing floods from uptown Nkwor Igbo-Ukwu Market axis. 6. Upgrade of Boys' Secondary School Igbo-Ukwu into a tertiary institution.
- Construction and modernization of the Nkwor Igbo-Ukwu Market and its road dualization.

Over 739km of roads now slash across the state, 420km commissioned, gleaming with fresh asphalt, stonebased and cement stabilization.

With wallets thinner than a razor's edge, he has avoided needless borrowing. Yet, Flyovers rise like phoenixes, and the Zero Pothole crusade has banished ruts to memory. This is what good governance can engender; it is a revolution, debt-free and defiant.

These infrastructural advancements have significantly improved connectivity within the state, facilitating trade and improving the quality of life for its residents.

Yet, behind these progressive policies lies an incredible work ethic. Soludo's hands-on approach to governance is well-documented; he is often seen personally inspecting project sites and engaging directly with community members. His administration has embarked on projects centred on transforming these areas into hubs of economic activity and human habitation, thus addressing long-standing issues of urban decay. 
What of the New new Government House and the Solution Fun City promises? Fully fulfilled, you can go and verify.








TWO YEARS OF IMPACT: HON. ENGR. DOM OKAFOR'S TRANSFOR-MATIVE LEADERSHIP IN AGUATA FED-**ERAL CONSTITUENCY**

Sworn in on June 13, 2023, amid post-election litigations, Hon. Okafor wasted no time proving that leadership is best defined by preparation and action. Armedwith a grassroots Needs Assessment Report he personally commissioned before his campaigns, and a comprehensive database of Aguata communities created post-election, he entered the legislature not merely as a first-timer but as a man with a plan.



Street lights now brighten five communities in Aguata, namely Isuofia, Ezinifite, Uga, Umuona and Igbo-Ukwu, thus enhancing security and ensuring that our markets and social life thrive beyond daylight hours.

Education remains at the heart of our mission—because we believe that the future of Aguata belongs to our children. That is why we built modern classroom blocks in primary schools, ensuring that every child has a conducive learning environment that fosters excellence. Specifically, we have completed the following educational projects:

- 1. Construction of Two (2) Rooms Class Block at Central School, Igbo-Ukwu.
- 2. Construction of Four (4) Rooms Classroom Block at Community Secondary School, Aguluezechukwu.
- 3. Construction of Six (6) rooms Class Block with furniture at Primary School Uga.
- 4. Re-roofing of Laboratory Block at Girls Secondary School Igbo-Ukwu.
- 5. Supply of Whiteboards, Pupils Desks, Teachers Chairs & Tables to Primary School, Obiuno Igbo-Uk-

Beyond this, we have assisted our students seeking admission into tertiary institutions and Corp members wishing to be posted to safer locations for their service year. We have equally assisted a good number of our young ones in visa processing and flight tickets for overseas studies. More so, we have issued Letters of recommendation to numerous members of our constituency seeking for employment in various establishments.

without stable electricity to drive businesses, innovation, and daily life, we are providing electricity transformers to some communities long deprived of reliable power supply.

Beyond infrastructure, we understand the necessity of human capital development. That is why we initiated the Skills Acquisition and Recreation Centre at Igbo-Ukwu—a project that will train our youth, empower our women, and create lasting opportunities for economic independence. This legacy project is more than bricks and mortar; it is a beacon of hope for the next generation.

Yet, perhaps the most touching of all our efforts this past year is the just concluded FREE EYE MEDICAL OUTREACH—a program that provided treatment to over 2,000 people who may have otherwise been unable to access proper eye care. THE EROSION MENACE IN IHITE IGBOUKWU

Erosion is one of the significant challenges in many towns in Anambra State and Igboukwu has share of this ugly monster tormenting lives and properties with little or not attention paid to it by government agencies and parastatals.

The peculiarity of a erosion in Umudege village of Ihite Igboukwu is that it is man-made and not a natural catastrophe.

It stems from wrong environmental impact assessment of Igboukwu - Ikenga road construction and drainage channelisation from Ohia Udo Ikenga down to Umudege village of Ihite Igboukwu.

Agu Okaforanika axis, another big erosion site in Ezihu village and other mini erosion sites scattered in Ihite Igboukwu must give us great concerns as erosion has a far- reaching implications on residents, infrastructures, agriculture and overall ecosystem health.

UNDERSTANDING EROSION

Erosion is the process by which soil and rock are removed from the Earth's surface by natural processes such as wind or water flow, and it can be exacerbated by human activities such as deforestation, poor land management, and urbanization. In Ihite Igboukwu, the combination of heavy rainfall, topography, wrong drainage channelization and inadequate drainage systems has led to increased susceptibility to erosion.

THE IMPACT ON IGBOUKWU

1) Threat to Agriculture: Agriculture is a vital part of the economy in Igboukwu, where many inhabitants rely on farming for their livelihoods. Erosion removes topsoil, which is crucial for crop production, thereby threatening food security and the economic stability of farming families.

2) Destruction of infrastructure

One of the visible impact of erosion in Ihite Igboukwu is the damage of roads electric poles, water reservoirs (wells), sewage tanks, wall fences and other critical infrastructures

3) Displacement of residents

As the erosion threatened lives and properties, homes and farmlands have been washed away, life of a 6-year-old child has been taken.

Residents around Obi Okoye/Ezeokana axes are forced to relocate.

This displacement if not checked can lead to a humanitarian crisis in Igboukwu if nothing is done urgently to curb this menace.

4) Environmental Degradation

These erosion sites are not only threat to human activities but also to Igboukwu ecosystem. It can lead to loss of biodiversity.

ADDRESSING THE EROSION CHALLENGES

To combat the erosion menace a multifacet approach is needed.

1) Legislation and policy implementation

It is verifiable that the root cause of erosion in Ihite Igboukwu particularly Obi Okoye/Ezeokana axes of umudege is wrong environmental impact assessment of construction of Igboukwu - Ikenga road and drainage channelization.

Recall there was a public hearing in Abuja tagged "Erosion menace ravaging Aguata Communities" through our Representative in National Assembly, Hon. (Engr.) Dom Okafor, MHR and committee on Ecological Projects and Environment.

That effort is yet to be fruitful, strong environmental policies that promote sustainable practices are critical.

2) Collaboration with Experts

Umudege village of Ihite Igboukwu has spent millions of naira to ameliorate this erosion problem using her local methods.

But engaging the environmental scientist and engineers can provide new insights and technological solutions to the erosion problem.

This collaborative efforts can also attract funding and support from non-governmental organizations.



3) Infrastructure Development

The involvement of local and state government in providing infrastructural improvement is eminent and essential.

Investing in proper drainage systems, retention walls and erosion control measures can mitigate the effect of erosion.

4) Awareness and Sensitization

Raising awareness in the affected part of Igboukwu about the causes and effect of erosion is crucial.

Educational programs can empower residents to adopt a better land use or management practices.

CONCLUSION

The erosion menace in Ihite Igboukwu presents a formidable challenge that requires immediate attention. By adopting a proactive and collaborative approach, the Umudege and Ezihu villages of Ihite quarter can work towards mitigating the impacts of erosion and safeguarding its future. Ultimately, addressing this issue is not only essential for the well-being of the residents but also for preserving Igboukwu lands. The time to act is now.

When Eze-Akajiugo Sir Barr. (Dr) MCK Ubah, the President-General of Igbo-Ukwu Development Union, IDU, was about to join the prestigious Nze N'Ozo Society of Obiuno Igbo-Ukwu on 23rd November, 2019, the usually difficult or herculean task of choosing the four (4) mandatory titles to be bestowed on him as his Nze N'Ozo titles ahead of the D-Day was just an easy walk-over.

Why? His would-be red-cap chieftaincy titles seemed to have been made in Heaven and tied or configured to his destiny right from birth! As it turned out on that blessed day of the induction, all the heavenly elements were 'so mixed in him that the whole world would rise up to say, in a ground-shaking unison: this is a man in whom we are well pleased!

As the first-in-town and uncommon names were being reeled out by Onyeisi Ebe-Ozo Obiuno, one after the other, all the Angels and Saints in Heaven joined the deafening thunderous ovations of human voices in shouting 'Hallelujah' to the glory of God!

As the evergreen legendary highlife maestro, King Oliver De Coque would say: agua (abaa) onye afa, Chi ya analu!! Again, Oke Dibia chua aja, odika ewelu ya nye ndi muo na aka... anaekwu na nkiti!

Of a truth, these Nze N'Ozo titles bestowed on our PG of Igbo-Ukwu by Ndi Nze N'Ozo Obiuno Quarter and validated by the entire Nze N'Ozo Igbo-Ukwu, were indeed special and uncommon in the whole of Igbo-Ukwu. Now listen and look at his Nze N'Ozo titular names once again:

1. Eze-Ekechukwu: This is a reincarnation of the revered Ozo title once taken by his maternal great grandfather from the royal Obinri Dynasty of

Ora-Eri Town - (an ancient renowned community rich in cultural antiquities, archaeological heritage of the Ancient Nri Cultural Dynasty of Igbo

2. Eze-Umeokwonna: a reincarnation of paternal great grandfather's title from the Umu-Nwugo Kindred of Ihuofor Village, Obiuno Quarter of Igbo-Ukwu.

3. Eze-Odebeatu: a title that originated from his Ward 8 people's acceptance and expression of validity and joy for all the indelible and giant strides of the PG right from birth as conveyed to him publicly by the Ide of Ihumabiam (Ward 8, Obiuno), being one of the most respected longstanding Ides in the Idu Cabinet of Igbo-Ukwu, Ide Linus Odika, during the first historic Mass Return Celebration (1995) of ndi Obiuno back in the years]. Nobody goes by these Ozo titles around town today. It took many decades afterwards for Obiuno to organise or host another epochal Mass Return Celebration (December 24-28, 2018) and this time under the distinguished chairmanship of Eze-Akajiugo. A visit to Obiuno community today would reveal a large sprinkles of the evergeen legacies of Eze-Akajiugo including the 2-Storey Obiuno Mega Civic Centre and the rejuvenated Obiuno Health Centre (powered by the Nnabugwu sons), all outcomes of Eze-Akajiugo's regime as Chairman of Obiuno Igbo-Ukwu (between 2016 and 2020). Go and verify!



And now hear the last title...

4. Eze-Akajiugo: This title remained one-in-town until late December 2024 when one of the four sons of my late friend - Engr Donatus Umenmuo - Umeakuewulu (from Ngo Quarter), took the title in obvious admiration of the Eze-Akajiugo's long-enduring collateral charisma and brand equity. But before this timeout, nobody in Igbo-Ukwu had ever taken or known by the name or title of Eze-Akajiugo na Igbo-Ukwu! Otua ka odi!

Over centuries, play-writers, dramatists, researchers, and personality psychologists have wondered what really is in a name! "That which we call a rose by any other name would smell as sweet." (Please see William Shakespeare's play "Romeo and Juliet"). But do we all believe or agree that: a thing is good if it's good, not because it has a good name attached to it. But if

this position is correct, why do some known good men and women avoid the name of Satan or Ekwnsu when choosing names or titles? Well, I leave all that decision up to you!

Eze-Akajiugo Sir Barr. (Dr) MCK Ubah is indeed a trailblazer! Call him Eze-Odebeatu na Igbo-Ukwu, which also fits perfectly to his trailblazing persona. Breaking existing records and setting new records is not new to him, going by his leadership precedents and antecedents starting from Ward 8 and down to Obiuno Quarter leadership. His has been a monumental legacy trajectory. He has never wavered, and it is certain that it's yet morning on Creatiion's Day!

Welcome to the National Secretariat (Headquarters) of Igbo-Ukwu Development Union, IDU, AmaehuluTown Hall, Igbo-Ukwu.

This newly furnished and commissioned National Secretariat of IDU is the first of its kind since the founding and establishment of the modern-day Igbo-Ukwu Development Union in 1977.

Before now, the IDU central office was either sitting on a privately rented apartment or tucked away in an obscure location away from the Amaehulu Town Hall estate. The last of such IDU offices is the one currently tucked away by the last IDU regime behind the backyard of Igbo-Ukwu Post Office at Nkwor Igbo Market. Team Eze-Akajiugo has been magnanimous in leadership continuity to have retained the place as an Annexe Office for IDU, which opens on Nkwor market days and one other day for ease of revenue collections or payments. Other days, daily administrative work and services take place in the IDU National Secretariat at Amaehulu Town Hall Igbo-Uk-

The IDU National Secretariat now houses all 15-IDU-elected officers, with each officer having an exclusive executive office, including the Office of the IDU Women Wing and a big EXCO Conference Room Each officer of IDU now has his own private office beginning with the PG's Office (housing a separate office for the Administrative Secretary and other PAs to the PG); the Office of the 1st Vice-PG; the Office of the 2nd Vice-PG; the Office of the Secretary-General of IDU and those of the Treasurer, Financial and Publicity Secretaries (including their Assistants). All these offices are fully furnished and functional.

The icing on the cake of this administrative initiative is that with Team Eze-Akajiugo, all the elected officers of IDU, inclusive of our Women's Wing, no longer wear their offices on their shoulders like the itinerary or roving police officers wearing their ranks about town on their shoulders,

going about without any fixed location or addresses, doing 'stop and search'.

Today, we now have our fixed, officially assigned offices to occupy and welcome visitors or other Igbo-Ukwu guests anytime. It's no longer only during the IDU bi-monthly General Delegates Meetings that you can find, visit, or talk with your elected executives of IDU. IDU executive committee members (EXCO member) can now come to the National Secretariat to hold their meetings anytime and any day they choose to meet. The time and era of going to hotels or members' homes to hold sensitive IDU Meetings are gone with the winds forever.

At Team Eze-Akajiugo, we are the change others want to see! We set new records and standards for coming generations! History remains the judge of all ages!





Only late Chief Tanu Umeweni immediately followed suit with his accompanying donation of that earliest edifice known today as the Igbo-Ukwu Museum.



That singular act of philanthropy earned him another solid chieftaincy title of IKENGA IGBO-UKWU! Oh how time flies!

Okeide Igbo-Ukwu loves anything associated with Igbo-Ukwu, his ancestral homeland. He is very passionate about Igbo-Ukwu; he dreams and wakes up with Igbo-Ukwu in his mind. Not too long after adorning his well-deserved title, he later became one of the most remarkable President-Generals of Igbo-Ukwu Development Union, IDU!

Among other notable achievements as the PG of Igbo-Ukwu, he was the founder and first Chairman of the Editorial Board of the now most attractive and bestselling community News-Magazine, east of the Niger: The Igbo Trumpet Magazine, the official newsletter of Ndi Igbo-Ukwu! ENTREPRENEURSHIP & OUR HEROES PAST

CHIEF EZEOCHENDOEMMANUELOKOYE

Emmanuel Echezonachukwu Okoye, the second child in a family of 7, was born on January 29, 1949, in Obiuno Igbo-Ukwu. After obtaining his Standard Six at St. Barnabas Primary School, Igbo-Ukwu, his father seconded him to his uncle, Dennis Aniemenam, a dealer in bicycle parts, as an apprentice. However, before he completed his apprenticeship, the civil war broke out and like the rest of his kinsmen, he ran for dear life and returned home. He willingly enlisted in the Biafan Army where he was responsible for the co-ordination of Biafran information affairs within the locality. After the war, he returned to Onitsha with his uncle, with the hope of continuing from where they stopped with the bicycle parts business. Unfortunately, on getting to Onitsha, they discovered that there was nothing to start with because there was no money and their shop and wares had been destroyed during the war. It was also difficult to import bicycle parts immediately after the war. With the old stock destroyed and new stock not forthcoming, his uncle was convinced that the bicycle business might not continue to boom as it had been and that it was not wise that two of them, the only breadwinners in the family, should continue in an apparently dying business, with poor prospects. He then advised Echezona to diversify into another form of business.

Luckily for him, his in-law, Chief E O Nnabugwu, was already a big-time liquor merchant in Onitsha and so, he enrolled as an apprentice again. Chief Nnabugwu opened a shop for him at 58 Iweka Road, Onitsha, and by 1975, he was settled and he started his own business. Luckily again for him, another in-law of his, Chief V.C. Agwuncha, was a Senior Manager with Nigerian Breweries, and following his advice and the persuasion of his good friend, Mr. Ben Nwafor, he opened a branch in Lagos in 1976, at 42B, Olumokun St., Amukoko and his company was registered as Echenzona& Alaba Trade Co. Ltd. His business grew in leaps and bounds and in addition to Nigerian Breweries, he established further business relationship with other companies, including, Guinness (Stout), CFAO (Maltex)

Associated Breweries and Sona Breweries. He was so good at the business that he was dubbed 'the liquor master'. He also established a branch, the Land Park Stores in Igboukwu, which was also a beehive of activities, in terms of liquor distributorship.

Somewhere along the line, he believed that a hotel business would complement his beer distribution enterprise and that was how he came up with the idea of establishing a hotel . The hotel project started in 1980 and was completed in November 1982 and that was the birth of Land Park Hotels Ltd. Without any hotel management experience, he took LandPark to enviable heights and it was among the best known hotels in that part of Lagos then, as an event center, relaxation spot and for lodging. He also decided to diversify further and established a cosmetics industry, leading to the emergence of Land-Park Industries, makers of Banana brand of cosmetics. Ochendo's business flourished and on two occasions, he won the coveted Nigerian Breweries Best Customer of the Year Award. In 1993, he was invited to Dublin by the Guinness family as one of the best dealers in Guinness. He was also invited in Canada in 1994 by a manufacturing conglomerate to strategise on the distribution of wine, another form of diversification from dealing in just beer and

Beyond his flourishing businesses, Ezeochendo was a sociable person, who also was interested in community building. He was the founder of ObiunoProgresive Union, which metamorphosed into the Obiuno Development Union, and mobilized Obiuno people for the rural electrification project. He hosted the meeting of IDU Lagos Branch for years at Land Park Hotels and before his death, was its chairman, during which the IDU hall became operational. He also represented Igboukwu in Aguata Progressive Union and Association of Anambra State Town Unions. He was a staunch member of Union Club Igbo-Ukwu, Odiri Social Club, Peoples Club and wasfirst non-Nnewi indigene to be admitted into Anaedo Social Club of Nigeria. He died in 1997

Post Script

Ezeochendo was a gifted entrepreneur who set the standards in his own sphere of business and who continued to seek for further opportunities because he believed that anahu an ofuebeeneemmonwu (you don't get the best by watching a masquerade from the same spot). He moved from bicycle parts to beer business, moved from Onitsha to Lagos, saw the linkage between beer distributorship and hospitality business and delved into manufacturing so as not to put all his eggs in one basket.

His story has a repertoire of entrepreneurial lessons including the following:


 He did not yield to despair due to the disruption of the civil war, which thwarted his apprenticeship and forced him to start afresh.

ii) He and his uncle read the environment very well, seeing that bicycle business had little prospects. They were engaged in environmental analyses, even though they did not appreciate what they were doing.

iii) Other people play key roles in peoples' entrepreneurial odyssey. His uncle, Chief Nnabugwu, his inlaw, Chief Agwuncha and his friend, Mr Nwafor were people through whom his entrepreneurial path was cleared.

iv) He successfully adopted the diversification strategy and that was how he moved from liquour to hospitality (related diversification) and manufacturing.

v) He took the bull by the horns, establishing a hotel without any formal training in the hospitality industry and was able to raise it to an enviable standard before his untimely demise.



SUSTAINING SPORTS TOURISM IN IGBO-UKWU AND THE ROLE OF IDU IN ACHIEVING THE TARGETS

Whenever the name of Igbo-ukwu is mentioned, those who are familiar with the archeological discoveries always think of the Roped Vase and other works of art. Today, the story is changing and rapidly changing for good.

The beauty about of this tremendous change is that the younger generation have taken up the challenge of not only being part of the history but also leading in the effort to re-write and control the narratives.

From the Igbo-ukwu Development Union, down to the Village Unions and Kindred families, everyone is becoming more aware and getting more interested on how they are governed and how the administration carries on their duties. As an egalitarian society, the people of the Archeological city both at home and in diaspora now have more opportunities to follow the trends of development, compare notes and also get involved. Kudos to the Shaw Institute for Cultural Art (SICA)group and others that have demonstrated visible interests in the renaissance. Thanks also to the wave of the social media platforms and the initiative of IDU to connect people online, to be part of the meeting processing.

My area of concentration in this write-up will also be on the way the Igbo-ukwuSports Tourism is rising and how IDU can help steady and propel the ship from different angles.

From the days of the Igbo-ukwu Town Union, to Igbo-ukwu Improvement Union (IIU), to Igboukwu Progressive union (IPU) and today, Igbo-ukwu Development Union (IDU), the idea of the development has always centered on physical construction, conflictresolutions, Land matters, Rights and agitations of Quarters and Wards. Less attention is always given to human and youthdevelopment. In fact, in estimation, ninety-nine percent (99%) of all the discussion at the IDU level centers on one project or the other, while only one percent (1%) is given to issues of Youth and Sports which are the driving force for everysociety, like ours, predominately dominated by the youths.

A clue from the international bodies will show how the United Nations, the African Union and Countries do not neglect or fail to create enabling environment for Youths and Sports activities to thrive. Over the years, most of the youth activities and sports programmes organized by the youth in the community is propelled by individuals(with minimal involvement by the IDU). Thank God that the current wave of the

individuals committing to the youth and sports programme is yielding fruit and boosting the Town's Sports ecosystem.

One group that has defiled all odds, and projected Igbo-ukwu sporting network is the Igbo-ukwu Football Association (IFA), a body that was founded in 1959 by sports volunteers and Teachers.

A deep dive into the sports profile of IFA, shows the wonderful exploits the Associationhas made. Theyinclude:

- 1. Total reorganization of Igbo-ukwu League system from the days of Late Chief F.O. Onyekwelu cup to the present Eze-ezinwan-neEzeohamadike cup. By December 2025, IFA will be completing the 62nd edition of the Premier League with Transition of 9 major cup tenures: Chief F.O. Onyekwelucup (1959 1995), Niger Optical Services Co. Nig. Ltd. (NOSCO Cup: 1996 2002), Chief Christopher Okonkwo (Ezeakudo Cup: 2003 2009), Nze Christian Okoli-Udeafor (Kotraco cup: 2010), Hon. IkemUzoezie cup: (2011 2014), Amara Iheme Trophy (2015), Engr. Bart Nwibe (Ugo Igbo-Ukwu Cup (2016 2019), IFA Cup (2020) and Nze Chucks Okoye (Eze-EzinwanneOhamadike Cup (2021 Date).
- 2. Introduction of an all-year-round competitions in Igbo-ukwu. These include IDU South Africa Branch Cup Primary schools and the Zaifa Cup by NzeUkwuomakpoligboChukwudiEzeifeorganized during the Easter Period. Eze-akaomajideaku Cup for Primary schools in August. The famous Igbo-ukwu Premier League for Eze-ezinwanneOhamadike Cup held during the Christmas Period by NzeChuksOkoyeand the Super-4 cup by OkenwaOkammutaGreg Ezeiloduring the New-year.

The 2024 Cup winner, IDU Lagos Branch Team will be expected to defend their trophy come December 2025 while Umudege Football Club will in 2026 defend their Zaifa Cup. Onitsha 2 is the winner of the Super-4 cup while Central School holds the title for the IDU South Africa Branch Cup for the Primary schools, 2025.

- 3. Apart from the above cups, there are Multi Sports Secondary School Sports competitions sponsored by Engr. Ikenna Okonkwo (ACOMEF) and other Igbo-ukwu personalities. The ACOMEF event flowsbeyond Igbo-ukwu and is a multi-community sports fiesta covering Athletics, Football, Volleyball and other sports. There are also other events in other sports.
- 4. Introduction of Women football and inauguration of a Committee to handle women football. Igbo-ukwu has never produced a National Women's team that represented the town. Today, the Igbo-ukwu Bronze Queens have not only taken part in several championships but have participated in the Anambra State Women's Football Championship with outstanding records. The Team is currently handled by an IFA Local Organizing Committee (LOC) that also has female members, as a way of encouraging gender inclusivity.
- 5. Mobilization of support for the Teams that fly the Town's flag at the Local Government and State Competitions. Through the effort of the IFA leadership, funds have been mobilized for the Men's, Women's and Primary school teams that represented the Town at the Local Government and state levels. Today, we celebrate the victoriousouting of the Town School in both football and other sports. Igbo-ukwuMen's Team came second in the Governor's Cup some years ago. The space will not be enough to mention names of all those that have supported the development of sports in the community in various ways.
- 6. Sensitization of the Branch and Village Sport Committees. Through the progress made in the sports circle, many Branches and Village Unions Sports committees are springing up with well-defined responsibilities. Some have gone extra mile to also organize events to prepare them for the future community competitions.

Taking sports as a key component of development and investing in it

This therefore raises the need for a deliberate attempt by IDU to always support sports development in Igbo-ukwu. Through sports, the energy of the youth in every society is harnessed and utilized positively.

Full Participation of the IDU Branches in the community events

Every affiliate Branch of IDU must be seen to be part of the activities of the Town union. Many Branches registered with IDU that have the capacity and number most often do not have clear cut obligation of their roles and responsibilities. Many have never gotten involved in the activities of the community and neither do they deeply connect to the community's events. Affiliation to IDU is beyond showing presence at

What is witnessed by IFA for over two decades now is the springing up of individually sponsored and Community football teams. This is a welcome development and the saving grace. If IFA had not thought outside the box and allowed individual clubs to register and compete, the almighty Annual Igbo-ukwu football championships, which started with the Branch participation, and comes up every yuletide, would have collapsed.
